

CUSTOM SUIT CONTEST RULES (the “Rules”)

Under the Custom Suit Contest (the “Contest”) organized by Collins Clothiers (the “Organizer”) and taking place between January 6, 2024 at 12:01 am EST (the “Contest Opening Date”) and May 12, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. EST (the “Contest Closing Date”), the contest winner (the “Winner”) will be chosen at random in a draw that will be held no later than May 30, 2024 for a total of one (1) Grand Prize Winner.

1. ELIGIBILITY

The Contest is open to all residents of Canada (excluding residents of the Province of Quebec), except for employees and agents and representatives of the Organizer.

2. HOW TO ENTER

2.1 No purchase necessary

2.1.1 To enter the Contest, the contestant (the “Contestant”) must fill out the entry form with all required information online at collinsclothiers.com/wedding-sign-up before the Contest Closing Date to be automatically entered.

2.1.2 The Contestant who has completed the online entry form is eligible for the Prize (defined below) draw after Contest Closing Date. Limit of one (1) entry per person.

3. AGREEMENT TO BE LEGALLY BOUND BY RULES

3.1 By entering the Contest, the Contestant acknowledges having read and understood these Rules and agrees to be bound by them and to comply with them. The Contestant declares that the Rules are understandable and reasonably available for consultation.

4. PRIZE

4.1 There will be one (1) Grand Prize (the “Prize”). The Grand Prize is one (1) Custom Suit (jacket and pant only). The Prize includes all applicable taxes. Any additional expense not mentioned herein shall be borne exclusively by the Winner(s) (as defined below). The total value of the Grand Prize is \$1,000 CAD before tax.

4.2 Without limiting the foregoing, the following general conditions apply to the Prize:

4.2.1 the Prize must be accepted as awarded and are not transferable, assignable or convertible to cash (except as may be specifically permitted by the Organizer in its sole and absolute discretion);

4.2.2 In the event that the Prize is not accepted in accordance with its attached conditions, the Prize will be deemed to be forfeited;

4.2.3 No substitutions are permitted, except at the option of the Organizer;

4.2.4 Organizer reserves the right at any time to substitute the Prize for any reason with a prize of equal or greater retail value, including, without limitation, but solely at the discretion of the Organizer, a cash award;

4.2.5 Colour and other specifics of the Prize will be at the sole and absolute discretion of the Organizer and subject to availability;

4.2.6 The Prize cannot be applied to past purchases or transactions;

4.2.7 Winner is solely responsible for all expenses that are not included in the description above, including, but not limited to, any upgrade or option package(s) that they may request (and that may be permitted by Organizer in its sole and absolute discretion).

5. DRAW

5.1 One (1) random draws will be held from all eligible entries received between the Contest Open Date and Contest Close Date. The draw shall be held no later than May 30, 2024, at 6:00 p.m., EST. in the offices of Collins Clothiers, 297 Adelaide St. S, London, ON N5Z 3K7.

5.2 The drawn name must be subscribed to the email database to qualify to be the winner.

5.3 The odds of winning will depend on the number of entries received.

6. PRIZE CLAIM

6.1 In order to be declared a winner, the selected Contestant must:

6.1.1 Complete the online entry form with all required information at collinsclothiers.com/wedding-sign-up;

6.1.2 Be reached by email or phone call by the Organizer within forty-eight (48) hours after the draw. If it is impossible to reach the selected Contestant by email or phone call within forty-eight (48) hours after the draw, all rights to the Prize will be forfeited;

6.1.3 Visit a Collins Clothiers corporate store or authorized affiliate location or attend a video call with Collins Clothiers and show a staff member a valid government issued piece of identification. There are five (6) Collins Clothiers corporate store locations in Ontario in the following cities: London, Kitchener, Windsor, Chatham, Barrie, and Hamilton. Authorized affiliate locations are located across Canada and can be found using the location finder on the website at collinsclothiers.com/locations;

6.1.4 Claim the Prize on or before May 30, 2025. Selected Contestant forfeits the Prize if it is not claimed on or before May 30, 2025.

6.2 In default of observing any of the conditions mentioned above or any other conditions stipulated in these Rules, the selected Contestant will be disqualified and the Prize that would have been awarded will be forfeited.

7. PERSONAL INFORMATION

7.1 From time to time, the Organizer, with the Contestant's consent, may use the personal information provided in the entry form for the purpose of:

7.1.1 Communicating with the winner so they can take possession of the Prize;

7.1.2 Communicating with the Contestant directly in relation to goods and services offered by the Organizer, including special offers and information on product and services; and

7.1.3 Conducting a survey regarding the effectiveness of the website, advertising, and sales efforts made by the Organizer.

8.2 The Winner hereby consents, without receiving additional compensation, to the use of their name, address (city, province), voice, statements, comments, photographs and/or other likeness, by the Organizer for any purpose whatsoever through all media, including, without limitation, the Internet for advertising or promotional purposes, and they agree to sign any additional document that could serve to assign the rights to their image, in particular, to Collins Clothiers.

8.4 Any forms that are incomplete, received after the Contest Closing Date, lost, irregular in any way or sent by an unauthorized method shall be deemed null and void and will not be accepted for the draws.

The Organizer is not responsible in any way for erroneous or inaccurate information, whether caused by website users or by the equipment and/or programs associated with or used by the Contest or by a technical or human error that may have occurred in conducting the Contest, including in the processing of entry forms. The Organizer assumes no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, loss or fault relating to operation or transmission, failure of communication lines, loss or destruction or prohibited access to or modification of the entry forms. The Organizer is not responsible for any injuries or damages that may result from the holding of the Contest. All entry forms become the property of the Organizer and will not be returned to the Contestants. The Organizer reserves the right to destroy all the documents pertaining to the Contest once the retention period as required by law has expired.
